



KEY EVENTS IN 2022

Basic Life Saving Course - Mandarin Oriental Hotel

24-hour CPR Marathon

Singapore Life Saving Society (SLSS) is proud to be a member of RLSS Commonwealth and committed to participating in a meaningful event on 29/09/2022 at 6pm. We invited members of SLSS to join us at our office located in Kallang Basin Swimming Complex for this one hour event.

In addition, SLSS took the initiative to raise awareness on the importance of CPR and collecting funds through our social media platforms. The funds raised were utilized to provide basic cardiac life support courses to underprivileged and low-income families. Our goal is to create an environment where everyone is equipped to perform this lifesaving procedure in case of an emergency with their loved ones.



Shangri-La Group – Life Saver Competition

On 10/10/2022, Shangri-La Group organized a Life Saver Competition for all lifeguards in four of its hotels. Singapore Life Saving Society was invited to attend the event as a special guest and provide officials to judge the competition. The primary goal of this event was to ensure that lifeguards are trained to meet the required standards and have quick reflexes when responding to actual situations.

RLSS Commonwealth Working Group - Bronze Medallion

SLSS has appointed Moe Aripe to represent Singapore in the working group.

The Bronze Medallion Working Group is responsible for

1. Reviewing and updating the existing key RLSS Bronze Medallion Resources (based on contemporary standards and research)

2. Investigating the status of the RLSS Bronze Medallion application and its relationship to Lifeguarding, with a view to producing a Position Statement

3. To give consideration to consistency of document presentation and branding such that all RLSS programmes (i.e. Survival Swimming, Bronze Medallion and Pool Lifeguard for Low Resource Settings) have a common look and brand.

Life Saving Instructor Course 2022

From 29/08/2022 to 16/09/2022, the Life Saving Instructor Course was conducted, aimed at individuals interested in acquiring instructional proficiency for promoting drowning prevention awareness and activities in Singapore.

The course was successfully completed, with a total of 48 participants, including 38 attending the Instructor Course and 10 attending Instructor Workshops. Due to the overwhelming response and high demand for this course, we are planning to conduct another class in the first half of 2023, providing more opportunities for individuals to enhance their instructional skills and contribute to drowning prevention efforts in Singapore.


RESERVES POLICY



- c. To fund purchases of property and rescue and other equipment


The Executive Committee reviews at least on an annual basis the number of reserves that are required to ensure that they are adequate.
